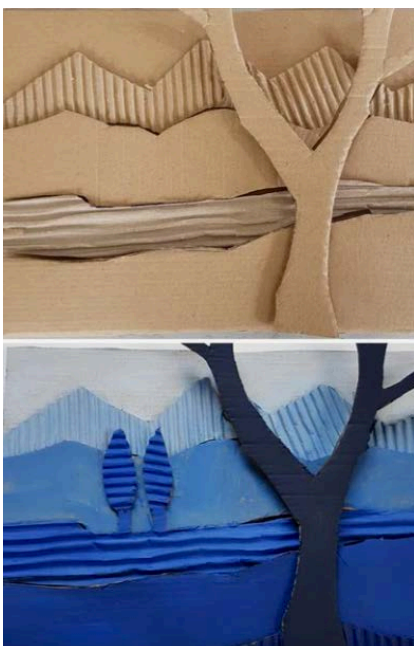
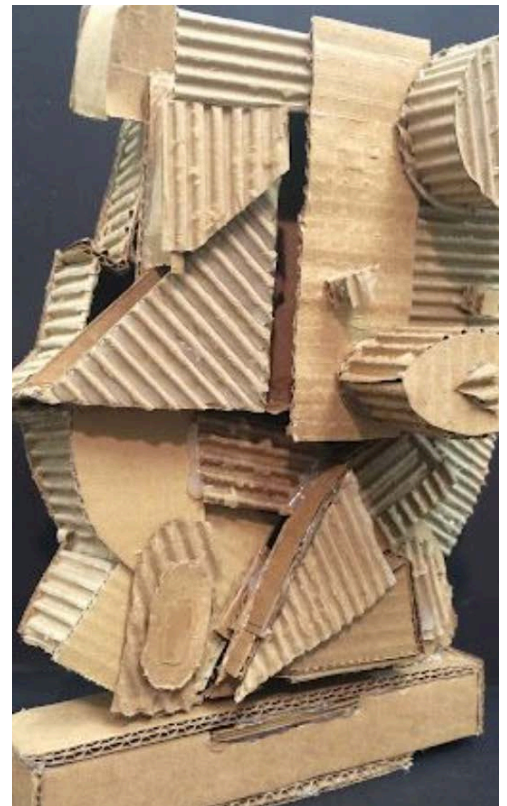

Look at all the ways you can use cardboard to create a sculptures!

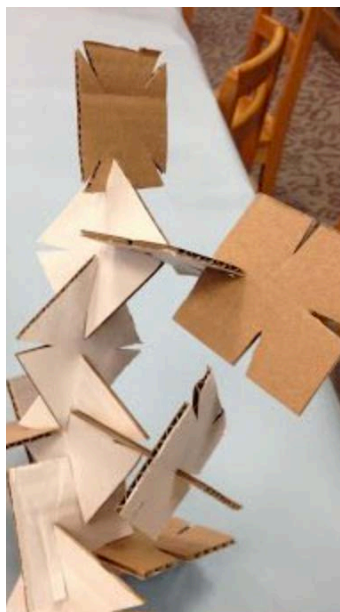
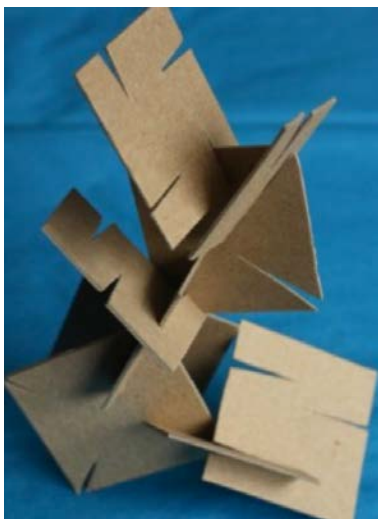
What will you create?

fasten with Elmer's liquid glue

Grades 6+

Cardboard Portraits

Start with a flat shape for face, neck and shoulders
Add pieces for each face element. Consider texture.
Consider using charcoal or pen for details.

tape/glue neck to the face
cut out paper details
color & glue on



K-3

Egg Carton Faces

Start with the egg carton lid, paint or cover in paper.
Add eyes, nose, mouth, hair, etc.

Paper Bag Poppies

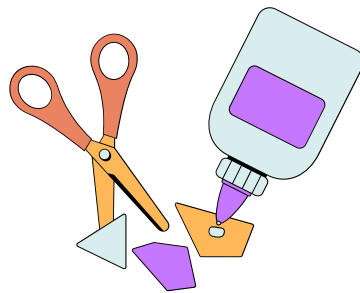
Ice cream?
