



Character Headband

STEPS:

- 1 Give students a strip of tag board (you can even use a file folder). Have them wrap it around their head . Tape or staple it like a headband.
- 2 Draw out shapes with construction paper and cut it out. Tape or staple to the headband to create their character.

Materials:

- tag board or file folder
- construction paper
- scissors
- tape or stapler
- pencil

Note: This project gets a "2" rating because it can be expanded upon, things can be added to build the costume or character. Possibilities are endless! Add on attachments or fabric, anything the kids can imagine.

Project Short Cuts and Do Aheads

- 1 Measure a few kid's heads to get idea of length needed
- 2 Pre cut the headband tag board/file folder.
- 3 Younger grades K-1 or special kids with special needs, you can provide pre-cut shapes in multiple colors. Kids will just need to glue together.

Watch Out For...

- 1 Keep it simple and let the kids PLAY!
- 2 To make this even simpler, you can give them a headband and have them color or draw on it. To make it more complicated you give them artificial leaves, flowers, etc to add as attachments - or - have kids plan their outfit to match the heads they create for a full body look!
